### WHAT CAN TELEICU DO FOR YOU?

University of Utah Health's TeleICU offers around-the-clock access to critical care specialists.

**ACUTE CONSULTATIONS:** Intensivists are available 24/7 to work with your clinical staff in managing acute medical issues or to help guide daily plans for your ICU or step down patients.

**NURSING SUPPORT:** Charge nurses are available 24/7 as a resource for your nursing staff to answer nursing care related questions

### EDUCATION:

- Weekly didactic sessions on a variety of ICU topics, offering 1 AMA CME or contact hour per session.
- Clinical, hands-on ICU training with University Hospital staff
- Other specialty education training

### HOW DOES TELEICU WORK?

TeleICU services offer 24/7 virtual consultation for:

- Management of inpatients with single and multisystem organ failure including:
  - Ventilator management
  - Acute/chronic renal failure
  - Cardiovascular instability
  - Sepsis, and more
- Acute resuscitation/stabilization of patients in the ED, step down or Intensive Care Unit
- Management of unstable patients awaiting transfer. Critical illness can happen anywhere, TeleICU puts critical care where you are. Our consultants will work with you to tailor critical care services to meet your unique needs.
