WHAT CAN TELESTROKE DO FOR YOU?

TeleStroke allows your stroke patients 24/7 access to world-class neurologists at University of Utah Health for acute stroke diagnosis and treatment, without leaving your hospital.

U of U Health stroke experts collaborate with your providers to determine the best course of action for each patient, avoiding unnecessary transfers so patients can receive care in their community.

WHY TELESTROKE?

Within minutes, U of U Health stroke neurologists can help diagnose a patient's neurological problem and recommend an immediate plan of care.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE TELESTROKE?

TeleStroke is available to any patient seeking acute stroke

care at a facility offering TeleStroke with U of U Health.

HOW DOES TELESTROKE WORK?

A TeleStroke consult is like a regular ED visit. The ED room is equipped with a cart, computer, and camera that connects to a U of U Health provider, allowing the patient to see the provider on the screen. Visits are private and confidential.

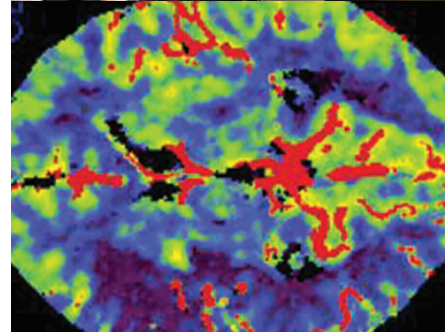
IS TELESTROKE EDUCATION AVAILABLE?
